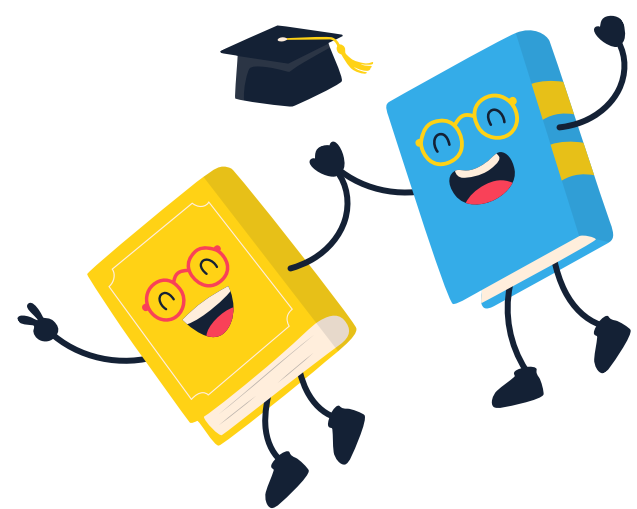

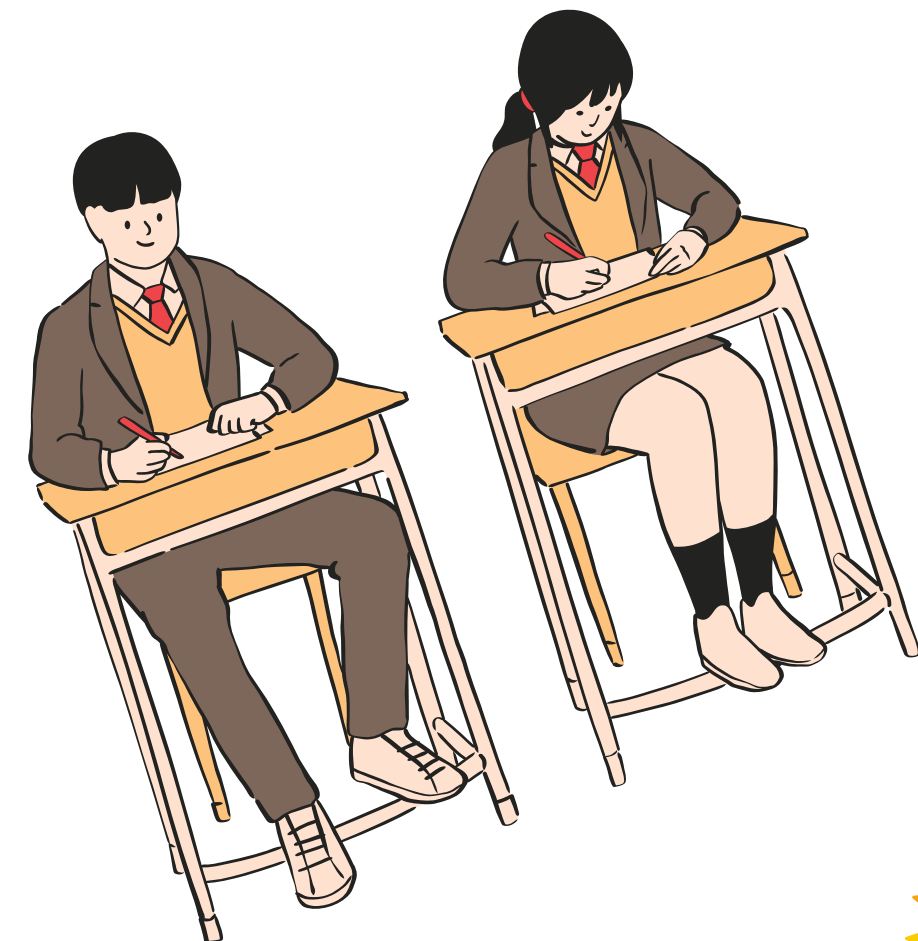

Bus Video Cameras

The Division believes the use of video cameras on school buses will enhance the safe operation of its school buses. Not all NWSD buses are equipped with video cameras, those that are, have signage at the front and back of the bus.
