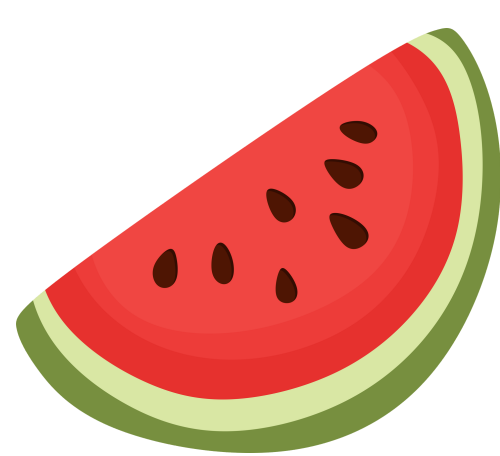
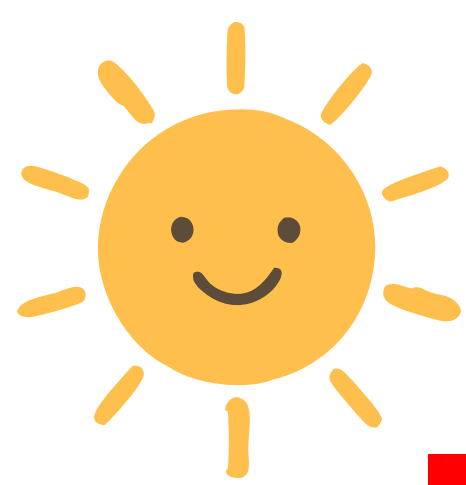

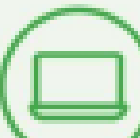

Breakfast Program

Mrs. Lockhart will have a hot breakfast item available every Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 8:40am-8:55am. This is available for all students, and it is free.

Locker Locks

Students are allowed to bring their own lock for their locker if they would like. The school does not provide locks.

Nut Aware School

Please note we are a nut aware school as there are severe allergies in the building.

Hat Policy

Grades 6-12 students may wear hats daily. Grades K-5 can pay \$1.00 to wear a hat on Fridays. All funds raised go towards the breakfast program. This policy may change throughout the year.

Bus Video Cameras

The Division believes the use of video cameras on school buses will enhance the safe operation of its school buses. Video cameras will enable school bus drivers to focus on the safe operation of the bus while improving student passenger identification procedures for disciplinary, medical emergency and other related purposes. Not all NWSD buses are equipped with video cameras, those that are, have signage at the front and back of the bus.
